



Opening / Unlocking / Locking Vehicle

What are the functions of the Remote Entry System?



- A** Unlock the vehicle
- B** Lock the vehicle
- C** Open tailgate and unlock doors
- D** Emergency key
- E** Panic button

Unlocking

Press button A on the key once.

The emergency flasher flashes once. The driver's door can be opened.

Press button A on the key twice.

The emergency flasher flashes twice. All vehicle doors can be opened.

Press button C on the key once.

The front luggage compartment lid is unlocked and all the doors can be opened. To open the front lid, raise the lid slightly and unlatch the safety latch with the red lever and then open the lid.

Locking

Press button B on the key once.

The emergency flasher flashes twice. The doors are locked. The interior surveillance alarm is activated.

Press button B on the key twice.


The emergency flasher emits one long flash. The doors are locked but can be opened from inside. The interior surveillance alarm is turned off.

HELPFUL TIP: Locking the vehicle but deactivating the interior surveillance alarm is useful should persons or animals remain in the vehicle.

Emergency Key

Insert emergency key D into the door lock F.

Turning the emergency key counter-clockwise unlocks the doors. Turning the emergency key clockwise locks the doors.



Opening / Unlocking / Locking Vehicle

How do I save my personal settings in my vehicle? OPTIONAL

With the ignition on, press the memory button **SET** and then press button **1** or **2** on the door panel within 10 seconds until an acknowledgement signal sounds. The ergonomic settings (seat, mirrors, steering wheel) are now stored on the corresponding button. Or press the memory button **SET** and then press button  to store the ergonomic and comfort settings (PCM, temperature, instrument cluster) on one of the keys.



To retrieve the individual preferred settings stored on the buttons, press and hold the corresponding button until the seat movement and other adjustment operations have been completed. The settings stored on the key are retrieved automatically after unlocking the car with this specific key.

HELPFUL TIP: If you would like to store the current settings on your key each time you lock your vehicle, please activate the "Auto Memory" function in the multi-function display under:

VEHICLE > SETTINGS > LOCKING > Auto Memory

If multiple drivers use the vehicle, assign a button to each driver and save the individual settings on a specific key via **SET** .

I notice more tire noise and tire wear than I've experienced with some other cars. Why is that?

Porsche cars are engineered for a high level of performance and are also designed to ensure safety, driving pleasure, comfort, and daily use. The hardness of the tire depends on the tire's temperature, as well as the compound specifications and the tread pattern of the tire. The side effects of these tire constructions may create louder noises while making a sharp turn when the tire is cold, such as pulling out of a parking spot.

HELPFUL TIP: All tires slowly lose air, and tire pressure also changes considerably when a tire heats up as a result of being driven. To keep tire noise and wear to a minimum, check tire pressure frequently and top off to recommended pressure. Also, have your dealership perform alignment and balancing at intervals noted in the Owner's Manual.

What should I know about the Tire Pressure Monitoring System?

As an added safety feature, your vehicle has been equipped with a Tire Pressure Monitoring System (TPMS) that illuminates a low tire pressure warning light when one or more of your tires is significantly under-inflated.

When the low tire pressure warning light illuminates, you should stop and check your tires as soon as possible and inflate them to the proper pressure. Driving on a significantly under-inflated tire causes the tire to overheat and can lead to tire failure.

HELPFUL TIP: While the vehicle is stationary, you can check the tire pressure within the multi-function display under:



TIRE PRESSURE > Fill Info

Fill Info shows the difference between the actual tire pressure and the required tire pressure.

What exactly do the **SPORT** and **SPORT PLUS** (OPTIONAL) buttons do?

The 911 is equipped as standard with a **SPORT** button.

When **SPORT** mode is on, the button illuminates and the optional PDK (Porsche Doppelkupplung) transmission switches to a sporty gear-changing map, shortened shift times, and earlier initiation of braking downshifts. Drivetrain and chassis components, depending on vehicle equipment, are also adjusted toward greater agility and driving performance.



For vehicles equipped with the Sport Chrono Package (optional): Vehicles with the Sport Chrono Package will feature the Mode switch on the steering wheel (0/S/S+/I), which omits the **SPORT** button on the center console. When the **SPORT PLUS** mode is on, the optional PDK transmission changes to a shift program designed for driving on race circuits and the gear-changing performance is enhanced significantly again, compared to **SPORT** mode.

Mode switch on the steering wheel selects the Normal, **SPORT**, **SPORT PLUS** and Individual driving modes. The center button is **SPORT Response**, which provides immediate performance-oriented settings for the engine and gearbox.

What should I know about manual transmission?

Gears 1 to 6 are designed for normal and performance-oriented driving (maximum speed is achieved in 6th gear). 7th gear is designed for reduced engine speed, so that an increase in comfort is achieved at higher speeds while, at the same time, reducing fuel consumption.

Neutral position: The neutral position **N** of the transmission is located in the shift gate between 3rd and 4th gear.

Selecting 7th gear: In order to prevent inadvertent shifting into 7th gear during sporty driving, a sequential gearshift lock has been installed. 7th gear can only be selected from an engaged 5th or 6th gear (see image, yellow line).



Shifting from 7th to 6th gear: Guide the gear lever with slight pressure to the right from 7th into 6th gear.

Shifting from 7th to 5th gear: Recommendation: From 7th gear, first shift to the neutral position **N** (gearshift lock active) and then into 5th gear.

What are the simplest ways to use the Air Conditioning System?

- **To activate automatic air conditioning:** Press button **D** to activate the cooling function. Press button **B** to deactivate the cooling function and switch off the air conditioning compressor.
- **To manually adjust the temperature:** Press button **A** up (warmer) or down (colder) to adjust the temperature.
- **To manually increase or decrease fan speed:** Press button **F** up (more) or down (less) to adjust the air quantity.
- **To activate A/C MAX mode:** Press button **C** to cool the passenger compartment at maximum power. The interior temperature is not regulated automatically when A/C MAX mode is activated.
- **To SYNC climate throughout cabin:** Press and hold button **D** until SYNC appears on the display to activate SYNC mode. Press button **D** or button **E** on the passenger's side to deactivate SYNC mode.


HELPFUL TIP: In SYNC mode, the temperatures on the driver's and passenger's sides are synchronized. When SYNC mode is on, driver and passenger temperatures are both regulated via button **A** on the driver's side.



How do I operate the multi-function display?

If equipped with a multi-function steering wheel, the multi-function display is operated via the following:


- **Turning A:** Adjusts the volume
- **Pressing A:** Mutes the volume
- **Pressing B:** Accepts a telephone call
- **Pressing D:** Ends or refuses a telephone call
- **Pressing C:** Calls up the stored function
- **Turning F:** Navigates up/down in the menu
- **Pressing F:** Selects/Confirms within the menu
- **Pressing E:** Moves back within the menu



How do I apply the electric parking brake?

The electric parking brake acts on the rear wheels and serves to secure the vehicle while parked.


- Applying the parking brake: Press button (P). The indicator light on button (P) and the brake warning light on the instrument panel come on.
- Releasing the parking brake: With the ignition on, press the brake pedal and then pull button (P). The indicator light on button (P) and the brake warning light on the instrument panel go out.



HELPFUL TIP: If the engine is running, the driver's door is closed, and the driver's safety belt is fastened, it is still possible to drive normally even though the parking brake is on. The electric parking brake detects the driver's intention to drive and releases automatically.

What do I need to know about the headlights?

When the light switch is in the AUTO position, the automatic driving light assistant switches on the driving lights (low beam) automatically depending on the ambient brightness. If equipped with High Beam Assistant (optional), a camera detects the light sources of oncoming vehicles, vehicles in front, or city lights and automatically selects between low beam and high beam. To activate High Beam Assistant, push the turn signal stalk once to the front pressure point 3.




How do I turn on the heated steering wheel? OPTIONAL

Press the button **A** in the central steering wheel spoke until the message "Heated steering wheel on" or "Heated steering wheel off" appears briefly on the multi-function display.



How do I set the time and date in the Porsche Communication Management (PCM) System?

The time and date settings can be found on the bottom right of the Porsche Communication Management (PCM) screen. On the PCM system, press the **CAR OR HOME BUTTON** > **SET**  > **SYSTEM** > **DATE AND TIME**. Here there are several options:




- **Auto time**
- **Time**
- **Date**
- **Date format**
- **Time zone**
- **Time format**

HELPFUL TIP: You will only need to set the time zone to automatic (Auto time), as your vehicle receives the correct time via GPS satellite signal. The time can also be found on the lower status area of the multi-function display.

How do I operate the convertible top? 911 CABRIOLET MODELS ONLY

The convertible top can be opened/closed and the windstop can be raised/lowered from within the vehicle's cabin.

- **Open top:** With the ignition turned on, pull and hold switch **A** until the convertible top has reached its end position.
- **Close top:** With the ignition turned on, pull and hold switch **C** until the convertible top has reached its end position.
- **Raise/Lower windstop:** With the ignition turned on, press switch **B** until the end position of the windstop is reached and the message on the multi-function display goes out.



HELPFUL TIP: The convertible top may only be operated when driving on a level surface and should not be operated in a strong headwind above approximately 30 mph.

Instruments and Controls

Where are the cup holders in the 911?

There are two folding cup holders behind the panel above the glove box. To access the cup holders above the glove box, press the center of the decorative strip and then press button **A**. Once the cup holder has extended completely, you can close the decorative strip.



What do I need to know about the 911 Targa Roof?

- **Opening Targa Roof:** Before opening, ensure there are no objects in the area behind the rear seats. Pull and hold the switch **A** until the Roof has reached its final position or until the windows are in their desired position. Releasing button **A** will interrupt the opening operation.
- **Closing Targa Roof:** Pull and hold the switch **B** until the Roof has reached its final position or until the windows are in their desired position. Releasing button **B** will interrupt the closing operation.




HELPFUL TIP: When the Targa Roof is opened and closed, the rear glass lid extends beyond the contours of the vehicle, so always **ensure sufficient clearance above and behind the vehicle when operating the Roof**. Rear ParkAssist is automatically activated when the Targa Roof is opened. If the sensors detect an obstacle at a distance of 16 in./40 cm or less, a warning message appears on the multi-function display. ParkAssist is NOT activated when using the rear glass lid release button next to the driver's seat. The roof system will operate only when the vehicle is stationary.

What do I need to know about the 911 Targa Air Deflector?

When driving at slower speeds, extending the Air Deflector can help to reduce wind noise. When driving at higher speeds, increased wind noise can occur when the Air Deflector is extended, so the Air Deflector should be retracted. The Air Deflector does not serve to reduce wind draughts in the vehicle interior.

- **Extending Air Deflector:** With the Targa Roof open, press on the Air Deflector **1** (arrow).
- **Retracting Air Deflector:** With the Targa Roof open, press down the Air Deflector **1** (arrow) until it engages in the windshield frame.




HELPFUL TIP: When the Targa Roof is closed and opened again, the Air Deflector remains in the last selected position.

Communication & Audio Controls

How do I operate the Porsche Communication Management (PCM) System?

- A. Adjust volume, switch PCM on/off
- B. Radio
- C. Media and radio sources
- D. Music and videos
- E. Phone, news, and emails
- F. Navigation
- G. Vehicle and system settings
- H. Map and traffic incidents
- I. Main menus, sound settings, Porsche Connect App, Apple CarPlay®
- J. Rotary push button (for controlling PCM)
- K. Undo button: Undo an operation, cancel a selection, or move up a level in the relevant menu
- L. Settings dependent on main menu and sound settings
- M. Setting the time
- N. Touchscreen (to operate PCM)
- O. Connection Manager (connecting a phone, displaying WiFi settings and setting up a WiFi hotspot, connecting Bluetooth® devices, displaying Apple CarPlay® and Porsche Connect App connection status)
- P. Skip buttons (set track/station)

How do I activate Bluetooth® Hands-Free Equipment for use with my cell phone?

You may connect your cell phone with the vehicle via Bluetooth®. We recommend that you do this together with your customer service representative at your authorized Porsche dealer. Pairing is as follows:




1. Determine if phone is compatible with the vehicle by visiting www.porscheusa.com or contacting your authorized Porsche dealer.
2. Ensure your phone is on and Bluetooth® is activated. If not, please activate now via the phone's settings. For some phones, you may have to activate the Bluetooth® visibility.
3. Select the **CONNECTION MANAGER** by pressing either  or  on the left side of the footer on your PCM screen.
4. Inside the **CONNECTION MANAGER**, select "PHONE." Here you can search for your phone by selecting "Search for a new phone." It may take a few moments for your phone to appear.
5. When your phone appears, accept or enter the Bluetooth® PIN code specified by the PCM system on the phone to complete the pairing process.

HELPFUL TIP: You can also manage phone settings from within the **PHONE** menu by pressing the **OPT** button just below the PCM module > selecting "**SET PHONE**" > "**BLUETOOTH.**" Here you can add a new device in addition to the one paired (although only one can be used at a time), manage existing devices including deleting devices off of the PCM system, deactivating Bluetooth® on the PCM system, and set up a helpful reminder to not forget your phone upon leaving your Porsche vehicle.


What should I know about Apple CarPlay®?

If equipped with an iPhone® device, Apple CarPlay® is a smarter, safer way to use your iPhone® in your car. It takes the things you want to do with your phone while driving and puts them right within the PCM display. You can get directions, make calls, send and receive messages, and listen to music. This acts in a way that allows you to stay focused on the road ahead. To engage Apple CarPlay® on your PCM, simply connect your iPhone® to the USB port found in the storage bin under your armrest. Once connected and terms are accepted on the PCM display, Apple CarPlay® will appear on your PCM screen. To exit, simply press the Porsche icon on the display. To find out if your iPhone® is Apple CarPlay® compatible, visit www.apple.com/ios/carplay.




How do I operate the Navigation System?

- A. Route guidance information, duration, and distance to destination or arrival time.
- B. Switch between scale display and auto zoom.
- C. Center vehicle position on map.
- D. Set map orientation to North up or direction of travel.
- E. Call up map page menu.
- F. 3D: 3D view (otherwise 2D view).
- G. **Traffic:** Show or hide traffic information on the map. Prerequisite: Data connection is established.
- H. **Traffic Flow:** Show or hide real-time Internet traffic information on accidents, road work, traffic flow information, and other incidents. Prerequisite: Data connection is established.
- I. **Show POI:** Show or hide points of interest on the map.



Searching an Address or Point of Interest (POI): The search functions can be accessed through the **NAV** button:

- J. **Search or Online search:**
 - Enter search term (e.g., city, house number, street name).
 - Select the correct entry from the list of suggestions.
- K. **House number, Street, City or Country:**
 - Enter a destination address.




- L. **Points of Interest**
 - Select point of interest.

- M. **Favorites** :
 - Scroll (swipe) to **CONTACTS** page.
 - Select entry from list.

Where are the USB/iPod® and AUX interfaces located?

There are two USB port locations in the 911. One is located in the center console underneath the armrest, and the other is located within the glove box. The AUX port is also found in the glove box.


HELPFUL TIP: To set up Apple CarPlay® via USB, please connect your iPhone® device via USB port found in the center console beneath the armrest. The other USB port in the glove box does not activate Apple CarPlay®.



Communication & Audio Controls

How do I operate Voice Control? OPTIONAL

To activate the voice control function, first ensure the ignition is switched on, there are no active phone calls, and ParkAssist is not active.



Activate Voice Control: Briefly press  on the control lever **A**. An ascending acoustic signal is heard, and the Symbol  for voice control appears on PCM. Proceed to say the voice command.

Deactivating Voice Control: Simply press  on the control lever **A**.

Activating Siri (via Apple CarPlay®): Hold  on the control lever **A** for approximately **3 seconds**. Siri will activate.

Voice Control settings can be found through the Porsche Communication Management (PCM) System:

CAR > **SET**  > **SYSTEM** > **Voice Control**
